



CHRISTIAN CITIZEN ALERT

The Hutchinson City Commission was recently approached by a lesbian-gay-bisexual-transgender (LGBT) activist group requesting consideration of an ordinance in Hutchinson. The requested ordinance would give special rights to individuals based on sexual orientation and gender identity. The commission is considering whether to move forward on the issue and may possibly cast a preliminary vote this month.

This proposal would extend legal protections to individuals based upon their sexual attractions and behaviors (homosexual or bisexual orientation). Additionally, it would extend protections to individuals who choose to identify themselves with a different gender than that determined by their actual biology (gender identity).

These proposed protections could open the door to new legal challenges in employment practices, housing policy and public accommodation (which includes any public restroom as well as public facilities like schools and daycare centers). If adopted, men who choose to identify themselves as women could demand to use women's restrooms and locker rooms.
